Sussex Kingsdown Floating Trophy:



Sir Robin Leigh-Pemberton was the Guest of Honour at the South African 1993 World Congress (first ever for Sussex). At the time he was Governor of the Bank of England - but was also a Sussex breeder. He later became Lord Kingsdown & presented two trophies for the herds with the best fertility - one for large herds & one for small herds. His son continues to breed Sussex on the family farm in Kent. Lord Kingsdown died about a year ago. - Anthony Evans

Aanhangsel stelsel of opgraderingstelsels

Die doel van die aanhangsel- of opgradering stelsel, is hoofsaaklik vir die uitbreiding van 'n ras se genepoel. Hiermee saam stel dit die ras in staat om vinniger in getalle te groei, en dit help nuwe toetreders tot die stoetbedryf, om met bestaande diere te begin as basis, en dan "op te teel" na SP status. Alhoewel dit as 'n lang proses gesien kan word, kan dit moontlik finansiële voordele vir die telers inhou. Gedurende die proses kan die teler die nageslag verkoop as "graad" bull of dan F1, F2 ens, op voorwaarde dat dit so gespesifiseer word, en sulke diere sal natuurlik nie die SX brandmerk op hê nie. Hierdie diere moet ook geïnspekteur word en aan die minimum rasstandaarde voldoen

Een voorbeeld van so 'n uiters suksesvolle kudde in die verlede is die gewese Skietlaagte kudde van Viljoenskroon.

Die spesifieke detail van die vereistes is in die Konstitusie van die Sussex Genootskap uiteengesit. Die proses verloop min of meer as volg (slegs voorbeeld met vroulike diere)

Aanhangsel A

1. Selekteer vroulike diere wat genotipies (met Sussex gene) en fenotipies (soos 'n Sussex lyk) Dit is Aanhangsel A (gestel dit was 'n 50/50 Sussex Afrikaner kruis wat soos 'n Sussex lyk)
2. Hierdie diere moet deur 2 senior inspekteurs van die Genootskap gekeur word
3. Nadat die diere gekeur is word dit op die stelsel aangeteken soos vir stoet diere. Huidiglik is die foie hiervoor 50% van stoetfoie.

Aanhangsel B

4. Paar die Aanhangsel A dier met 'n SP Sussex bul. Die vroulike nageslag is nou Aanhangsel B.
5. Vir Aanhangsel B diere is die foie 75%

SP Sussex

6. Paar hierdie Aanhangsel B vroulike dier weer met 'n SP Sussex bul
7. Die nageslag hiervan is 'n SP dier

Hierdie diere moet elke jaar geïnspekteur word.

Die proses sal ongeveer 8 jaar neem. Gestel jy doen dit met 50 van jou kommersieële diere, dan was dit nie nodig om 50 SP koeie aan te koop nie. In die 8 jaar selekteer jy jou vervangings verse en verkoop die res, so geen inkomste gaan verlore nie. Die bulletjies selekteer jy as graad bulle en verkoop as sulks, en die res word bemark soos gewoon. Jy verloor geen inkomste nie, en verhoog jou inkomste deur graad bulle te verkoop. Dieselfde proses kan van die manlike diere se kant af gedoen word, maar is nie so eenvoudig nie.

Hierdie is egter 'n stelsel wat met groot verantwoordelikheid en deursigtigheid gedoen moet word en ek versoek telers wat van hierdie stelsel gebruik wil maak, om my persoonlik te kontak, waarna ek en 'n ervare senior keurder u persoonlik sal besoek.

Ek moedig alle telers of voornemende telers om hieraan deel te neem. Dit sal 'n groot inspuiting van genetica in die Sussex ras wees, en ons in staat stel om vinniger te groei

KZN Sussex Club – 2015

This year 3 breeders exhibited at the Regional Sussex Championships at the Royal Show. The participants

came from three different Provinces: Bulls Run from Himeville, KZN; Grey Maclean from East London (E Cape) and Vigorex (Free State). From a total entry of 8 animals the winners of the main classes were: Junior and Grand Champion Sussex Bull:- LAM13/03 (Bulls Run); Senior champion Bull:- 12/294 (Grey Maclean); Junior and Grand champion female JS12/26 (Vigorex). Special thanks to Linden Hewson who travelled 14 hours from East London and this after an interval of 18 years since his last outing to the Royal Show!

Clubhouse: Prior to show week the KZN club received a grant from the Sussex Society, which allowed us to renovate the clubhouse building and with help from

the RAS in supervising the contractors. The clubhouse is now in a good condition and ready to host many more championships in the future!

The annual newsletter was sent out in August to all members of the Club as well as commercial buyers in the Province.

KZN club now has 14 commercial members who are kept up to date with activities in the Province and who now also receive the national Society Newsletter.

A VISIT TO SUSSEX ENGLAND

Having been a stud breeder since 2009, it was interesting to be able to visit the home of the breed this year. During June the calves were already 3 months old and the summer was proving to be drier than usual. I first visited a commercial herd of Sussex near Oxsted in Kent. The 300ha farm with a manor house dating back to 1540 is managed by Bill Peters and consists of steep, rolling hills with some arable cropping in the valleys. Bill manages 160 cows singlehanded and only has the help of his wife when he needs to inoculate animals. These commercial cows weigh around 550kg and wean calves of around 240kg at 6 months. As can be seen from the photo, the modern Sussex has a very smooth coat in summer.

The next farm to be visited was near Mayfield in Sussex. Here a registered Sussex herd of 70 females is managed by Brenda Hide on 200ha of typical heavy Sussex clay soil. Members who attended the International Congress last year will remember meeting Brenda (who also judged with Martin Seyferdt). The emphasis in the Mayfield herd is breeding larger framed, polled animals as the trend is to reduce costs and stress of dehorning wherever possible. I estimated that the average weight of the large framed Mayfield cows was around 700kg.

Breeders in Britain started to introduce polled genetics about 20 years ago, making use of an appendix system using selected Red Angus bulls. Some F3 polled bulls' semen was exported to South Africa in turn, where a number of F4 bulls are now available in addition to the polled Sussex lines from Australia. In the picture can be seen large framed 7/8ths Sussex cows weighing 700kg plus, being mated to a medium frame traditional bull with medium-early maturity and good muscling.

Traditionally animals were housed in partly covered cattle yards and fed with hay, turnips or swedes and which was supplemented with oilseed cake. In Sussex with its heavy clay soils, cows are nowadays kept indoors for as short a time as possible and fed mainly silage in the winter months. This is not because of the cold temperatures but to save the pastures from excessive trampling, as animals would otherwise spend a lot of time in mud up to their fetlocks. The cows normally calve from March-April and then fend for themselves from May to October.

Historically in this area Sussex oxen were trained to the plough at three years old and worked for another three years before being finished for the butcher. Any animals with a poor temperament were culled, and the result is that Sussex are very docile and to this day are easy to handle.

In Southern England in summer, flies on cattle are a constant problem. To combat this an ear-tag is available which releases controlled amounts of a pyrethroid and which lasts the whole summer. These tags are removed at the end of summer and replaced with new tags when the build-up of flies reaches a problem level. (See pic attached).

Sussex het as mede hoofborg opgetree, en ek het die geleentheid gehad om as spreker op te tree, en sodoende die ras te promoveer. Wat 'n uitstekende geleentheid vir boere om die unieke eienskappe van Sussex in die praktyk te sien!

Baie geluk aan mnr Dallas Phillips van Huntersvlei met hierdie besondere prestasie, en vir die lede van die Sentrale klub vir die deelname en reëlings.
